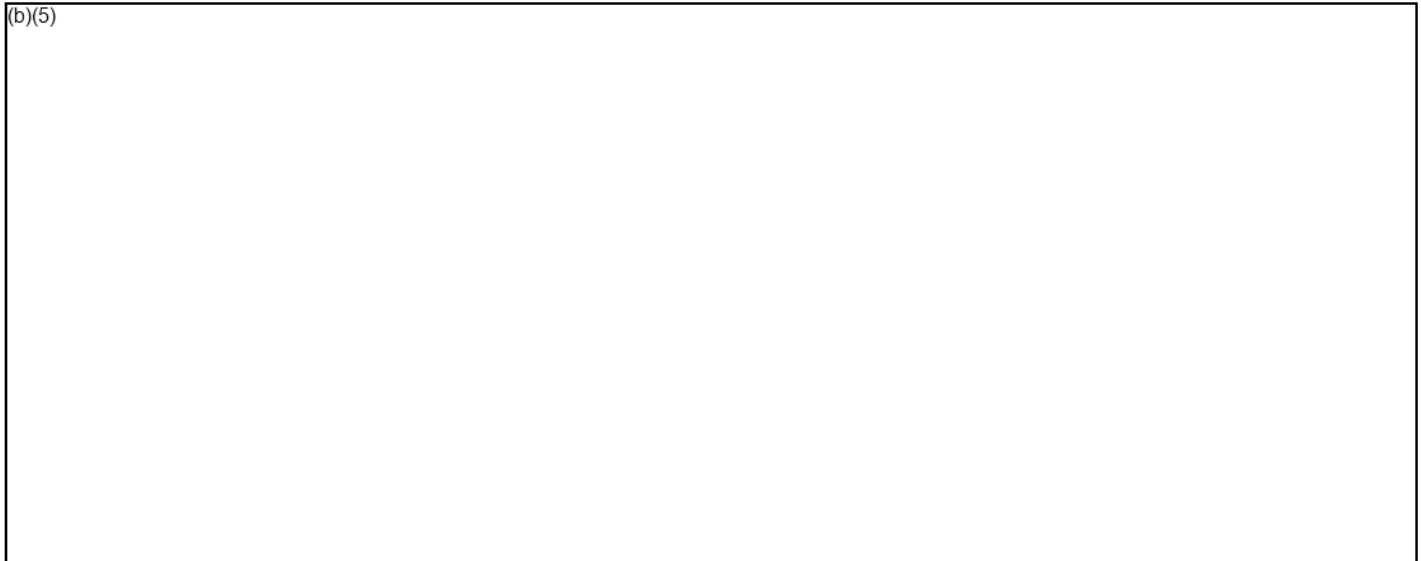

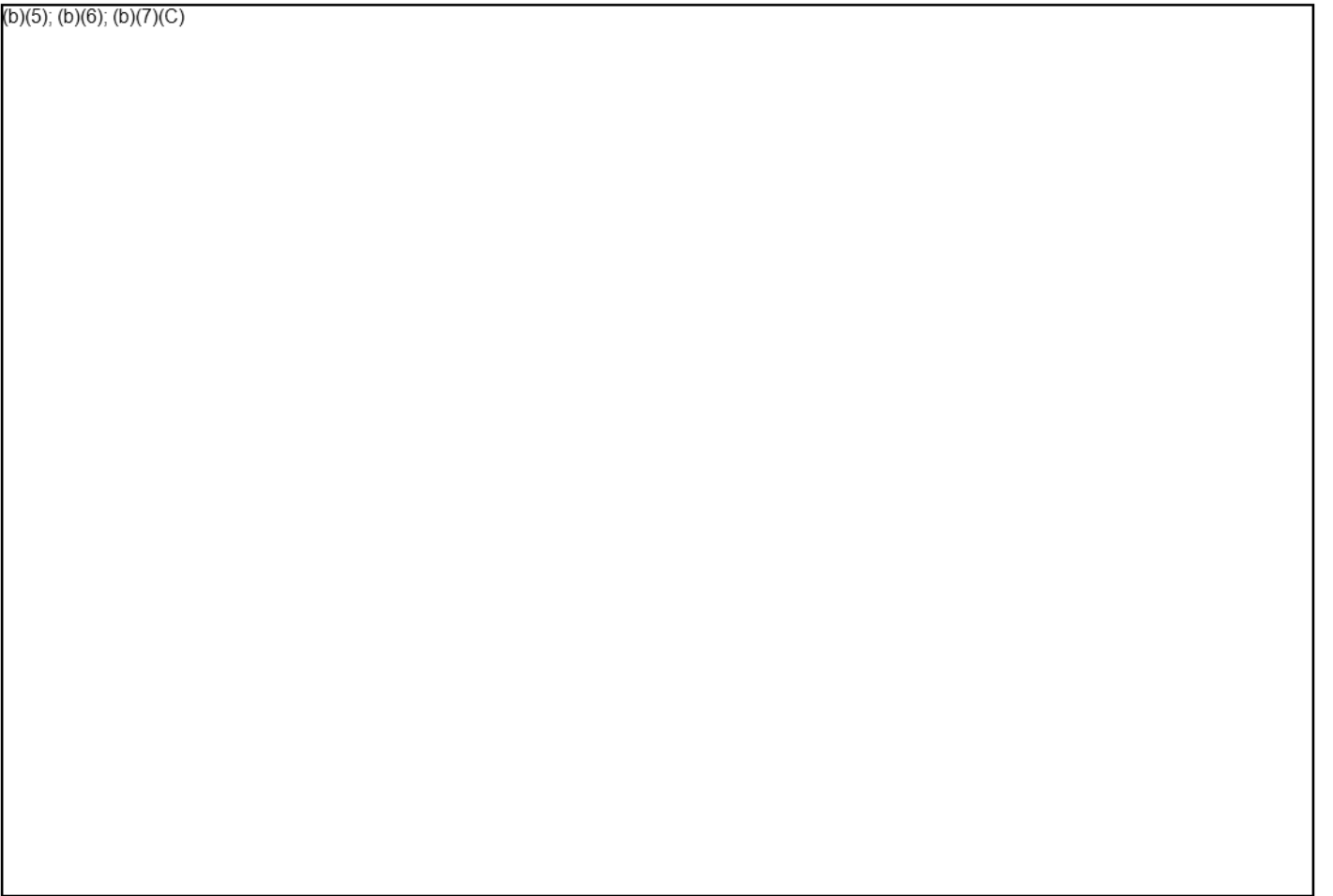

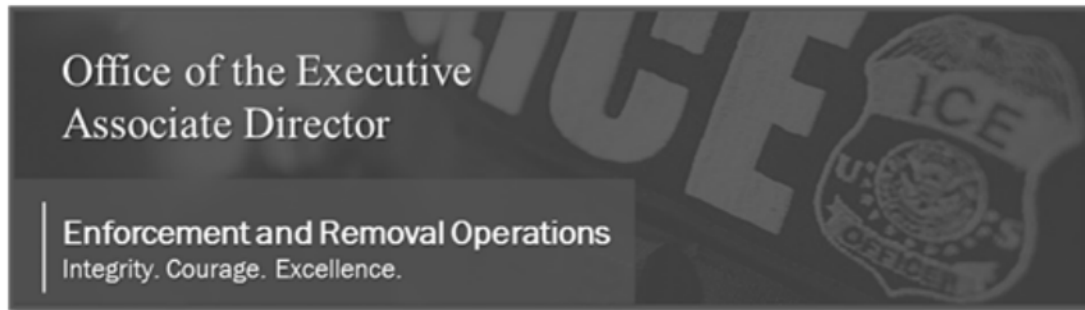

ISSUE:

On January 26, 2021, Enforcement and Removal Operations (ERO) Los Angeles plans to remove (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) a citizen of El Salvador, with a final removal order to El Salvador via ICE Air Charter aircraft (b)(6); (b)(7)(C); (b)(7)(E) (b)(7)(E)

BACKGROUND:

On an unknown date, (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) entered the United States (U.S.) at an unknown place without having been admitted or paroled by an immigration officer.

On May 9, 2005, U.S. Border Patrol (USBP) arrested (b)(6); (b)(7)(C); (b)(7)(E) and served him with a Notice to Appear (NTA), Form I-862, charging removability pursuant to Section 212(a)(6)(A)(i) of the Immigration and Naturalization Act (INA), as an alien present in the U.S. without admission or parole. USBP released (b)(6); (b)(7)(E) on an Order of Release on Recognizance, Form I-220A, (b)(7)(E). The NTA was not properly filed with the Executive Office for Immigration Review.

On November 3, 2005, (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) filed an Application to Register Permanent Resident or Adjust Status, Form I-485, with U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS).

On April 3, 2008, USCIS rejected (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) Form I-485.

On April 29, 2015, the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles, convicted (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) of the offense of DUI and sentenced him to 13 days in jail. ERO Los Angeles did not encounter (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) pursuant to this conviction.

On May 16, 2016, the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles, convicted (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) of the offense of battery and sentenced him to 60 days in jail. ERO Los Angeles did not encounter (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) pursuant to this conviction.

On June 5, 2019, ERO Los Angeles served (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) an NTA while in custody at CIM, pursuant to Section 212(a)(6)(A)(i) of the INA, as an alien present in the U.S. without admission or parole, and ordered him to report to ERO Los Angeles upon release from CIM.

On October 3, 2019, ERO Los Angeles arrested (b)(6); (b)(7)(C); (b)(7)(E) and transferred him to the Adelanto ICE Processing Center.

On March 11, 2020, an Immigration Judge (IJ) in Adelanto, CA, (b)(6); (b)(7)(C); (b)(3):Unspecified Statute (b)(6); (b)(7)(C); (b)(3):Unspecified Statute

On April 6, 2020, (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) filed a case appeal with the Board of Immigration Appeals (BIA).


