I am writing with additional information regarding Mike’s message below. Today, the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Texas issued a temporary restraining order (TRO) enjoining and restraining the Department of Homeland Security from enforcing and implementing the policies set forth in Section C, Immediate 100-Day Pause on Removals, of Acting Secretary Pekoske’s June 20, 2021 memorandum, titled *Review of and Interim Review to Civil Immigration Enforcement and Removal Policies and Priorities*. A short summary of the order follows, and a copy is attached.

Texas v. United States, No. 21-00003 (S.D. Tex. filed Jan. 22, 2021). On January 26, 2021, the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Texas issued a temporary restraining order (TRO) enjoining the Department’s implementation of the 100-day pause on removals of certain individuals with final removal orders set forth in Acting Secretary Pekoske’s January 20, 2021 memorandum, titled *Review of and Interim Review to Civil Immigration Enforcement and Removal Policies and Priorities*. The district court found that the pause violates section 241(a)(1)(A) of the Immigration and Nationality Act, 8 U.S.C. § 1231(a)(1)(A), which provides that “when an alien is ordered removed, the Attorney General *shall* remove the alien from the United States within a period of 90 days[.]” (emphasis added), and that that statute affords no discretion to the Secretary to “blatantly disregard the 90-day removal rule without finding that an enumerated exception applies.” Order at 8. The district court also found a likelihood of success on the merits of Texas’s claim that the January 20, 2021 memorandum is arbitrary and capricious because it was issued “without any consideration whatsoever of a [more limited] policy.” Order at 9 (quoting *Dep’t of Homeland Sec. v. Regents of the Univ. of Cal.*, 140 S.Ct. 1891, 1912 (2020)). The district court found that the January 20, 2021 Memorandum not only failed to consider potential policies more limited in scope and time, but it also failed to provide “any concrete, reasonable justification” for a 100-day pause on removals, noting that it was not clear why the 100-day pause is needed to accomplish the goals in stated in in the January 20, 2021 Memorandum. The district court did not base its ruling on the SAFE Memorandum of Understanding between the prior Acting Deputy Secretary and the State of Texas.

The district court rejected the government’s argument that 8 U.S.C. § 1252(g) bars judicial review, instead finding that Texas’s claims did not constitute claims arising from the government’s decision or action to execute removal orders brought “by or on behalf of any alien.” 8 U.S.C § 1252(g). The district court also found Texas’s allegations of standing and irreparable harm based on alleged financial injury sufficient under Fifth Circuit precedent. Finally, the district court found that injury to Texas outweighed harm to the federal government and would not undermine the public interest. The district court noted that the federal government is “free to conduct a ‘measured and considered assessment’ of immigration policies regardless of the existence of the January 20, 2021 Memorandum’s 100-day pause.” Order at 13.

OK. To be clear, from ICE Air – both flights today would have gone anyway as they were charters to Mexico filled with recent border entrants (b)(7)(E)

As for the three commercial removals that occurred today, all would have gone anyway as well. Two were recent entrants and one was a judicial order.

So, ICE Air has not yet removed anyone who would have otherwise not qualified for removal under the 100 day pause.

It is anticipated that there will be some on the Jamaica flight, and I know Field Ops has already reported back that none would have gone under the memo.

1. For your visibility, there are a total of 7 air charter removal flights scheduled for Friday. Two are Mexico flights which would have gone anyway. For all others -- the El Salvador, Ecuador, Honduras and Guatemala manifests would have to be vetted to determine to determine who would have qualified for removal under the 100 day pause.
