This is the fourth interim response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), received on April 4, 2022.

DHS reviewed 521 pages for this production. Of the 521 pages, 49 pages are being released in full, 140 pages are released in part, and 34 pages are being withheld in full pursuant to (b)(6) and (b)(5); and 262 pages have been determined duplicative or non-responsive. The 223 pages are Bates Stamped DHS-1255001003 05/31/2023 through DHS-1255001225 05/31/2023.

In addition, 36 pages are being sent for further consultation within DHS, with other DHS components or with other government agencies.
