This is the sixth interim response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), received on April 4, 2022.

DHS reviewed 421 pages for this production. Of the 421 pages, 157 pages are being released in full, 118 pages are released in part and 23 pages are being withheld in full pursuant to (b)(3) (6 U.S.C. 1504(d)(3)), (b)(5), (b)(6), and (b)(7)(E); and 103 pages have been determined duplicative or non-responsive. The 298 pages are Bates Stamped as DHS-1255001489 7/31/2023 through DHS-1255001796 7/31/2023.

In addition, 20 pages are being sent for further consultation within DHS, with other DHS components or with other government agencies.
