This is the eleventh interim response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), received on April 4, 2022.

DHS reviewed 432 pages for this production. Of the 432 pages, 70 pages are released in part pursuant to (b)(3) (6 U.S.C. 1504(d)(3)), (b)(5), (b)(6), and (b)(7)(E); and 346 pages have been determined duplicative or non-responsive. The 70 pages are Bates Stamped DHS-1255-002762 12/22/2023 through DHS-1255-002831 12/22/2023.

In addition, 16 pages are being sent for further consultation within DHS, with other DHS components or with other government agencies.
