Election 2020 Disinformation Sitrep – November 9th

There has been little change to the disinformation activities in the past 24 hours. The narratives remain largely the same and trends toward use of platforms beyond mainstream social media continue. Red font below provides updates.

Mis- and Dis- Narratives Driving the Day

Call to Action: Violent Rhetoric in Extremist Groups Incorporating Election Uncertainty

- EIP detected extremist chatter, including in Telegram groups and QAnon circles, continuing to insinuate that the uncertainty around 2020 election is indicative of the collapse of society, and that the election is the culmination of a long-standing cultural conflict. As the temperature begins to cool in the mainstream, these groups express surprise that others remain calm and suggest “taking matters into their own hands.” This reporting was echoed by the Anti-Defamation League (ADL). **Update: discussions on several platforms about a 14 November march in Washington and potential for clashing with counter-protestors was reported today.**

False Narrative: Errors in Michigan Unofficial Results Reporting Insinuates Voter Fraud

- False claims are circulating among political influencers and social media users that a misreported figure by a clerk in Antrim County, MI that was quickly corrected is evidence of broader fraud in the ballot counting process in Michigan. This narrative has seen significant spread in the last 24 hours following propagation by prominent political influencers on social media and elsewhere.
- This narrative has also recently included Dominion Voting Systems, an Election Management System used by Antrim County, as well as purported voting software “hammer” and “Scorecard.” Videos and social media posts, as well as political influencers, claim that political operatives have used these systems to manipulate the unofficial results reporting process.
- Counter-messages: CISA Rumor Control, [Michigan Secretary of State](#), [EIP](#)
- **Update: this narrative continues to spread on several platforms, driven by additional articles by political influencers, which implicate additional political operatives as part of a widespread conspiracy.**

False Narrative: Deceased Voters and Violations by Vote Counters

- Legitimate livestream videos of legal vote-counting activities are being taken out of context to allege malfeasance in the count process in battleground states. Specifically, conspiratorial content is using events on the stream such touching a pen, filling out a ballot copy, looking around the room, or the camera panning away to allege fraud.
- A number of Twitter accounts posted links to a Pastebin dump containing what they claimed is a list of “14+ thousand dead people who voted” in Detroit/Michigan. Multiple different videos surfaced allegedly showing poll workers in Pennsylvania fabricating ballots to inflate voter tallies. Some comments on the videos explain that workers are not committing fraud but tracing ballots which could not be read by the machines.

Mis- and Dis- Trends from Election Official Reporting Channels

Content from official reporting channels is tapering off, as expected. A significant portion of reports coming through the channel seems to come after 3rd Party fact checkers have drawn attention to the problematic content.

Recurring Narratives, by frequency (Table 1 for breakdown):

- Suspicion of vote-count spikes, suddenly “finding” ballots, and “clerical errors.” Suspicion persists around what users perceive to be odd spikes in vote counts in the middle of the night. This especially applies to sudden, large spikes favoring one candidate.
- Suspicion of unusually fast result-calling, especially with votes outstanding. Now that the major media outlets have called the presidential race, this narrative may evolve to target this aspect.
- Allegations of partisan poll workers ejecting or sending home observers. This relates to the prior bullet point. Suspicion also persists around poll workers, perceived to be partisan operatives, allegedly ejecting poll watchers, covering windows, and/or forcing observers to stand far away so they can covertly commit fraud. GA was mentioned specifically.
- Poll workers engaging in tabulation fraud, or discarding votes. PA was mentioned specifically.
- USPS whistleblower exposing the backdating of ballots. This has persisted from yesterday, when an online media organization posted a video of an alleged Postal Service whistleblower.
- General suspicion of fraud. E.g. Allegations of corruption; DHS watermarking; VBM permanently entrenching one party in power in CA/OR/WA; ineligible voters voting; etc.

Be On the Lookout For:

- Past debunked events to resurface as certification process begins and media organizations declare a winner of the presidential race
- Existing narratives to cement unless factual counter-messaging takes root.
- Extremists escalate calls to action and violent rhetoric as unofficial counts conclude
- Continued claims of fraud, particularly based on video/alleged whistleblower testimony
- More concerns around ‘unexpectedly found’ ballots
- Continued amplification of disinformation by blue checks and political elite elevating risk of physical security incidents at election locations (e.g. canvassing facilities) and to prominent election officials
- Livestreams using real and fake “live feeds” of unrest, ballot counting, etc. to support widespread fraud or unrest narratives
- Pivot from ballot counting and polling locations to disinformation and calls to action related to the electoral college and associated electors
- **Continued claims of CISA’s involvement in ballot production/manipulation as part of a wider operation.**

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Foreign State-Backed Election Disinformation

Russian State-Backed Media: The majority of Russian state-backed media outlets have pivoted to the U.S. election. Many of these outlets and Kremlin-backed proxy websites have amplified misinformation on voter fraud. Additionally, these Russian-backed outlets have focused on unrest in American cities, highlighting instances of violence, clashes with the police, and the allegedly growing number of arrests. This content has tended to strike a foreboding tone, warning of an unstable future for both the U.S. and other countries if Biden wins the election, or if the winner remains unclear.

Several articles have also amplified false reporting on supposed fraud in vote counting or published misleading content about the results of the election. Facebook pages of some the main Russian state-backed outlets are also actively covering the updates on the elections, protests, and the latest comments on fraud accusations.

Covert Troll Farm Run by Chinese National: Alethea Group identified a large network of social media accounts assessed to be part of the troll farm operated by Chinese billionaire Guo Wengui, as detailed by a recent New York Times [article](#). These accounts are operating on mainstream social media platforms, such as YouTube, Twitter, Instagram, and Reddit, but also on fringe platforms that promote themselves as platforms for the right, such as Gab and Parler. Alethea Group also found one post from this network on Russia's VK and another on China's Weibo. These accounts are actively posting content aimed at the US election, including amplifying false or misleading content about voting, and amplifying domestic misinformation.

The accounts have heavily promoted election-related conspiracy theories, including the conspiracy theory that former presidential candidate Michael Bloomberg is funding alleged Antifa plans to conduct riots around the White House after Trump declares victory. The accounts have also actively promoted QAnon-related conspiracies and anti-Chinese Communist Party content.

Hammer and Scorecard RFI Summary

Note: This summary aggregates initial findings in response to a CFITF Request for Information on Nov 10, 2020, from the following respondents: State-Global Engagement Center, FireEye, Deloitte, Digital Forensic Research Lab, the Election Integrity Project (EIP), the Foreign Policy Research Institute, Facebook, and Twitter. **Do not further distribute without first reaching out to the Countering Foreign Influence Task Force ((b) (6)).**

Bottom Line:

- References seemingly peaked over the weekend and have not exhibited signs of virality beyond invested audiences. Estimations of false amplification are hindered by a statistically relevant amount of newly created accounts contributing to the spread (underlying explanations are disputed).
- Platform response has been robust, including both diversion to fact-checking and labelling. This coupled with numerous wide-reaching fact-checks and counter-messages by 3rd parties may account for the narrative's migration to smaller platforms including Parler and Rumble.
- Evidence of foreign amplification is sparse, but present, with some overt foreign propagandists referencing the conspiracy along with other threads to undermine faith in the election process.

Background and Timeline

After initially appearing in 2016 and resurfacing in 2017 and 2018, the Hammer and Scorecard narrative has been recycled in the 2020 Presidential Election to undermine faith in election outcomes and further agitate vulnerable right-leaning audiences. The current outbreak seems to have begun with an Oct. 30th article highlighting the conspiracy with little engagement until it was featured on a prominent alt-right livestream on Nov. 2nd. Following election day, the narrative has been increasingly merged with others aimed at undermining the election results under the umbrella call to action, "Stop the Steal."

While there are now several permutations of the conspiracy theory, the core elements allege that a whistleblower leaked knowledge of a government-built secret supercomputer, HAMMER, and a software component, SCORECARD, being used by Deepstate operatives within the Federal government to change election tallies on behalf of the Democratic Party. Various incarnations posit that this computer and program were developed by the previous administration, used unsuccessfully in the 2016 general election, and was knowingly 'optimized' by pushing mail-in voting under the guise of COVID-19 precautions.

Platform Response and Counter Messaging

Twitter, Facebook, and YouTube have all taken remedial actions against this narrative and have prioritized it in their response efforts. After an initial attempt at automated labelling which was stymied by an apparently coordinated 4Chan effort to reverse engineer the labelling logic, Twitter is currently manually labelling and identifying prolific spreaders. Facebook is currently fact-checking and down-ranking posts spreading the narrative. YouTube is currently providing 3rd party fact-checking in search results. However, a popularly-linked article pushing the disinformation is highly ranked on the results of many search engine, above fact-checkers.

Counter-disinformation organizations and election integrity operations are flagging the conspiracy as such and have resoundingly debunked. These posts are receiving an above baseline level of engagement, suggesting some efficacy.

In response, propagators have been evolving coded and evasive language to reference the narrative and evade remedial action. See below for an example that also attempts to boost the narrative by tying it to a trending disinformation topic alleging election vendor malfeasance.



Spread and Engagement:

Posts propagating this narrative exhibit a high number of links back to known disinformation purveyors, fringe media sites, and video content from channels known to post problematic material. A video hosted on Rumble, a less-restricted alternative to YouTube, has, as of the afternoon of Nov. 10, accumulated more than 200,000 views.

Engagement on the larger platforms seems to have picked up on the evening of the 6th following a tweeted video interview with the defense attorney of one of POTUS's former National Security Advisers, who claimed that "the Hammer" and "Scorecard" were used to change "3% of the vote total...in the pre-election voting ballots that were collected digitally...across the country." The bulk of post volume accrued over the Nov. 7-8 weekend. Twitter data exhibits a series of spikes in engagement in posting starting morning of the 7th and diminishing to steady low levels by the afternoon of the 9th; the narrative does not appear to have held any sustained level of attention during this period. Measuring engagement with this particular narrative will become increasingly difficult as it continues to be subsumed into larger meta-narratives invoking themes of fraud and Deepstate corruption and emerging conspiracy theories latching onto breaking news.

Current spread of the narrative is relegated largely to the less popular platforms, Parler and Rumble, and is presumably still circulating unchecked on the Chans. EIP has noted a discernable migration of the narrative to the smaller platforms, which may be attributable to counter disinformation efforts on the larger ones. It is unlikely that engagement will grow significantly in volume on these platforms, given the general proclivities of the platform membership, but may increase in temperament as the echo chamber effect pushes polarization and reinforcement. These newer, smaller, platforms have shown to be ill-suited for wide dissemination and there are numerous examples of viral narratives causing the sites to go down due to capacity restraints. It is likely that members with significant followers on both large and small platforms will attempt to reseed the narrative on large platforms while content continues circulating the smaller platforms.

False Amplification and Foreign Propagation

At this time, signs of covert foreign amplification of the Hammer and Scorecard narrative or evidence to suggest it originated from foreign actors is scarce. The narrative topology instead suggests that the narrative is sustained largely by grassroots amplification and exhibits a fair degree of authenticity. The topology, however, may be distorted by quick platform efforts targeting viral spreaders and influencers, which could effectively mute spikes in amplification efforts. Other traditional indicators of false amplification are similarly muddled by the platform response; for example, the narrative spread involves a statistically high number of newly created accounts which is strongly correlated to historic false amplification efforts, but may, in this case, reflect member account suspensions resulting in new genuine account creation.

Some limited overt foreign amplification is observed, however. Known Russian accounts have retweeted members of POTUS's campaign staff who have used the hashtag #HammerAndScorecard. These accounts have also retweeted the Fox News segment in which the Hammer and Scorecard narrative was discussed. Several of these accounts received up to 6k retweets, and many accounts

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interacted with each other to further amplify the narrative. This includes Russia-nexus site News Front publishing an article in Russian on “Trump’s Victory Confirmed by Quantum Blockchain Recount.”

* (U//FOUO) Russian election interference isn't anything new; as [Moldovans](#) go to polls Sunday (1 November), they will be electing a president under the watchful eye of Moscow which wants the polarized country to remain in its orbit amid political and security crises on Russia's borders. The impoverished country of 3.5 million has been divided between those favoring closer ties with the EU, in particular Romania, and those who cling to Soviet-era relations with Moscow. With the last leader being pro-Russian, a new leader could swing the country back closer to the EU. By studying the tactics, techniques, and procedures (TTPs) used in this election, especially if there is a cyber intersection, perhaps the US, and especially CISA and I&A's Cyber Mission Center, could leverage our knowledge of those identified TTPs to protect our election. With so much hanging on the trustworthiness of the election, [European allies](#) have concerns about the election, especially regarding threats from [Russia](#) since the 2016 elections remain a tension. If there is a dispute due to a cyber concern, how negatively would that affect the economy, especially since there have [multiple attempts](#) at hacking sensitive critical infrastructure?

The users stated that with an individual's first name, last name, and date of birth it was possible to view and change a voter's registration. The users shared screenshots that showed registered voters' county, party, residential and mailing address, and ballot status. The users shared screenshots that possibly indicated that a ballot can be printed off the website and then submitted.

2. (U//FOUO) Source A created a thread about the State of Oregon's Election Website and discussed the ability to lookup registered voter's personal information with only their name and date of birth, and stated, "[...]What's worse is that you can change people's registration information once you are on their page.[...]". Source A posted a screenshot of the "My Vote" system with an option for an individual to update a voter's registration, and stated, "Can you really just [expletive] over someone from getting their ballot or change their party here?"

3. (U//FOUO) Source B posted multiple statements and images. Source B stated, "YOU CAN ACTUALLY VOTE ON THERE [...]", "[...] This is from my friend from high school I know his dob and it let me mark his ballot" (Collector Comment: "dob" likely refers to Date of Birth), "Not fake, I clicked 'mark my ballot'", and "YOU CAN PRINT IT OFF AND BRING IT TO THE COURTHOUSE [expletive]...NO ID REQUIRED". Source B posted an image which showed an "Official Ballot" with the option to select a candidate for President and Vice President, and an image which showed an individual's name, voter status, county, party, residential and mailing address, ballot status, and multiple linked options.

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4. (U//FOUO) Source C posted a screenshot with an individual's voter registration and a fillable ballot, and stated, "HOLY ACTUAL [expletive] I literally can't believe this. I just tried [U.S. Person] and checked different years. I'm not going to actually click it but holy [expletive]. Literally unbelievable that you can make unlimited requests without a rate limit. This is unprecedented."

5. (U//FOUO) Source D posted an image that showed the process of accessing the "My Vote" system and showed screenshots of a fillable ballot. One page displayed a fillable ballot that stated, "Only for use by Military, Overseas and Voters with Disabilities". Another page stated, "Summary of your votes. After reviewing, print this page and return it to your County Election Office."

6. (U//FOUO) Source E posted a screenshot from the "My Vote" system showing the information of an American celebrity and shared a link to a list of celebrities that live in Oregon. Source E stated, "sure would be a shame if you know ... [Website listing celebrities living in Oregon]".







I&A has previously written analyses about disinformation related to vote by mail, including from the Russians. Disseminating this OSIR, which not only fails to correct the disinformation but seems to give it credence, would seem to operate at cross purposes to I&A's, and CISA's, mission of debunking election disinformation.

This particular OSIR came to my attention because Sen. Wyden's office tracks the election process in Oregon. How many OSIRs is I&A disseminating nationally on election matters and what is I&A doing to ensure that its products serve to educate rather than misinform its customers?
