This is the fourteenth interim response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), received on April 4, 2022.

DHS reviewed 400 pages for this production. Of the 400 pages, 55 pages are being released in full, 70 pages are being released in part, and 6 pages are being withheld in full pursuant to (b)(5) and (b)(6). 269 pages were determined to be nonresponsive or duplicative. The responsive pages are Bate Stamped DHS-1255-002905 03/29/ 2024 through DHS-1255-003038 03/29/2024.

In addition, we received 3 pages of consultations and are releasing in part 3 pages pursuant to (b)(6) and (b)(5).
