This is the fifteenth interim response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), received on April 4, 2022.

DHS reviewed 401 pages for this production. Of the 401 pages, 111 pages are being released in full, 35 pages are being released in part, pursuant to FOIA Exemption (b)(6). I have considered the foreseeable harm standard when reviewing the record set and have applied the FOIA exemptions as required by the same statute and the Attorney General's Guidance. In addition, 255 pages were determined to be nonresponsive or duplicative. The 146 pages are Bates Stamped DHS-1255-003039 04/25/2024 through DHS-1255-003184 04/25/2024.
