Dear Mr. Block,

This is the sixteenth interim response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), received on April 4, 2022.

DHS reviewed 400 pages for this production. Of the 400 pages, 286 pages are being released in full, 14 pages are being released in part pursuant to FOIA Exemption (b)(6), and 17 pages are being withheld in full pursuant to FOIA Exemption (b)(5). I have considered the foreseeable harm standard when reviewing the record set and have applied the FOIA exemptions as required by the same statute and the Attorney General's Guidance. In addition, 83 pages were determined to be nonresponsive or duplicative. The 317 pages are Bates Stamped DHS-1255-003185 05/28/2024 through DHS-1255-003501 05/28/2024.
