**Re: Pennsylvania Right to Know Law Request**

This firm is counsel to America First Legal Foundation (“AFL”) Under the Pennsylvania Right to Know Law, 65 § 67.101 et seq., AFL is requesting the below records. These record requests are related to the attempted assassination of President Donald J. Trump at the Butler Farm Show Grounds in Butler, PA on July 13, 2024.

**RECORDS REQUESTED:**

To advance the public interest, AFL requests the following records and communications:

1. All student files, records, or documents for Thomas Michael Crooks.
2. All records and communication related exchanged relating to Thomas Michael Crooks.
3. All disciplinary records or complaints concerning Thomas Michael Crooks.
4. All communication, emails, text messages, chat sessions, or other forms of written or electronic communication containing the name “Thomas Michael Crooks.”

If there are any fees for searching or copying these records, please inform us if the cost will exceed \$100. However, we would also like to request a waiver of all fees

in that the disclosure of the requested information is in the public interest and will contribute significantly to the public's understanding of how the Pennsylvania State Police responded to the assassination attempt of President Donald J. Trump. This information is not being sought for commercial purposes. Further, we would like to request partial records if all records cannot be provided at once.

The Pennsylvania Right to Know Law requires a response time within five business days. If access to the records we are requesting will take longer than this amount of time, please contact us with information about when we might receive records.

If you deny any or all of this request, please cite each specific exemption you feel justifies the refusal to release the information and notify us of the appeal procedures available to us under the law.
