The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has processed your June 10, 2022, Freedom of Information Act request as EPA-2022-004717. This request is the subject of litigation in the case *America First Legal Foundation v. U.S. Department of Agriculture et al.*, Case No. 1:22-cv-03029 (D.D.C.).

You are seeking the EPA's "strategic plan," that was required by Section 3(b) of Executive Order 14019 on "Promoting Access to Voting," to be submitted to the Assistant to the President for Domestic Policy by September 23, 2021. The Office of the Administrator conducted a search and located the responsive record.

Upon review of the responsive record, the EPA determined that the record is exempt from mandatory disclosure under Exemption 5. The three-page responsive record is withheld in full.
