

Hi Pam,

Based on our conversations, we are now aiming to hire 11 attorneys under our current ad, plus the 2 honors attorneys we have been assigned by CRT, for a total of 13 permanent new attorneys in Voting. As I mentioned, we are doing reference checks for our first batch of interviewees under our ad, and are interviewing a second batch now. At present, we would have 8 vacancies in attorney slots, I believe, before new hires are considered. My understanding that is the 2 Honors attorneys will be assigned to temporary slots and will not encumber our attorney slots. So by my math, we will need to at least temporarily occupy at least 3 more attorney slots in this fiscal year to fully staff up on attorneys under our ad (11 new attorneys hires minus 8 vacancies equals 3 more vacant slots needed for attorneys). Darlene seemed to think with retirements and normal turnover, that should not be a problem to find those additional vacant slots.

For non-attorney slots, we would have 4 vacancies, I believe, before the new hires are considered. We have already devoted 1 of those 4 vacant slots to the CAPS paralegal we have been assigned by CRT. We expect to need 3 more CAPS paralegals assigned to VOT, and we have slots for that in the short term. We also want to (b) (5)

But I understand that what is set forth above is correct.


