These documents were produced as part of a settlement with Judicial Watch regarding a similar FOIA request. Additionally, to explain why these are the only documents under the control of the Agency, we include the additional documents from the case JW v. DoD, No. 23-3109 001 through JW v. DoD, No. 23-3109 009.
