Dear Mr. Rubinstein:

As we noted in our letter dated November 29, 2024, we are processing your request for material under the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), 5 U.S.C. § 552. The Department of State ("Department") has identified 21 additional responsive records subject to the FOIA. Upon review, we have determined that all 21 records may be released in part.

An enclosure explains the FOIA exemptions and other grounds for withholding material. Where we have made redactions, the applicable FOIA exemptions are marked on each record. Where applicable, the Department has considered the foreseeable harm standard when reviewing these records and applying FOIA exemptions. All non-exempt material that is reasonably segregable from the exempt material has been released and is enclosed.

We will keep you informed as your case progresses. 


Yes, in mid-Oct the White House took issue with FB/Twitter's decision to moderate a posting about Hunter Biden. It triggered the latest efforts by the White House.

On Tuesday, President Trumpthreatened to veto must-pass defense policy legislation unless lawmakers agree to repeal internet platforms' Section 230 protections, which he claimed were "a serious threat to our National Security & Election Integrity." Several Democratic lawmakers quickly criticized and questioned the move. The threat to veto appears to be a continuation of the Trump Administration's complaints against what they describe as the social media platforms' biased actions against conservative content online. The White House on 28 May released the Executive Order on Preventing Online Censorship in reaction to a deleted Republican tweet, and on 27 July the Commerce Department sent a related petition for rulemaking to the Federal Communications Commission, called "NTIA Petition for Rulemaking to Clarify Provisions of Section 230 of the Communications Act."



With "disclosure" about his emails, the hunt for Hunter Biden has reopened

New revelations about the son of US presidential candidate Joe Biden are met with skepticism by US media.

History seems to be repeating itself: Shortly before the US presidential election, there is another big leak of emails that could get the Democratic candidate in trouble.

But while the hacked emails of the Democratic Party in 2016 dominated the news for weeks and thwarted Hillary Clinton's campaign, in 2020 there is still more skepticism at the revelations, which came out through the New York Post. The newspaper, which is known for being slightly sensationalist and Trump-friendly, got its hands on the emails through Rudy Giuliani, adding to the mistrust of the authenticity of the documents. Giuliani is Trump's personal attorney, who in

the past has already released many theories about the Bidens in Ukraine, which turned out to be untrue.

Major social media companies such as Facebook and Twitter had their scripts ready this time, and immediately took steps to curb the spread of the news story until finding out more about the authenticity and origin of the emails.

What about the Bidens in Ukraine again?

In 2014 Hunter Biden joined the board of the Ukrainian energy company Burisma for a generous salary. His father Joe was vice-president under Obama at the time, and his portfolio included Ukraine.

Few believe that Hunter Biden was hired solely because of his unique knowledge of the Ukrainian gas market, and that his political connections had nothing to do with it. The lucrative sinecure of Biden Jr. certainly does not reflect well on the Bidens.

But there has never been any evidence of actual influence. Joe Biden has always said he never talked to his son about Ukraine. Indeed, it has never been proven that Burisma or Hunter Biden influenced US policy, despite unremitting efforts by the Trump camp to make it plausible.

What's the news?

The New York Post released an email on Wednesday in which a Burisma official reportedly thanked Biden in 2015 for "the opportunity to meet your father and spend some time together." If that meeting did take place, it would mean that Joe Biden was not telling the truth when he said he never talked to his son about Ukraine. The newspaper itself calls it a "smoking gun".

How credible are those revelations?

Experts are skeptical. The New York Post also published private photos of Hunter Biden from the same data breach, which appear to be authentic. But it is unclear whether the email itself is authentic: the newspaper only shows a photo of the email, which was taken this week. Original metadata is missing. The archives also seem to indicate that Joe Biden had very different activities in his agenda on the day in question than a meeting. He may have shaken hands briefly in passing.

The email is said to have come from a laptop Hunter Biden allegedly left at a repair shop and never picked up. The store manager says "almost certain" that the laptop was brought by Hunter Biden himself, but he has a visual impairment, so says he cannot vouch for it. The fact that he then made the laptop available to Rudy Giuliani, Trump's personal attorney, who has been trumping unproven conspiracy theories about the Bidens in Ukraine for years, makes most experts even more skeptical. Giuliani did not respond to requests from other media to inspect the mail.

How harmful is this to Joe Biden?

Biden now has a few street lengths ahead in the polls, so could have something. Both mainstream and social media are more wary this year than in 2016, limiting the chances that this story will make headlines for weeks, as long as the evidence for it remains as sparse as it is today.

But attention to the opportunistic affairs of his son in Ukraine does him no good in principle. Even though Joe Biden is not personally responsible, the smell of favoritism hangs around his son's lucrative business, and Joe Biden is often irritated when he is asked about it.





As of 29 October, we found at least six publications on SouthFront regarding the Hunter Biden laptop scandal and alleged audio recordings. These articles are both SouthFront original content and republications from other websites. The publications referenced below range from 22-28 October 2020, and reference the Hunter Biden audio recordings and laptop scandal to include alleged sex tapes, pedophilia, and ties to China. As of 29 October, we found at least six publications on the Strategic Culture Foundation regarding the Hunter Biden laptop scandal and the Bidens' alleged involvement in Ukraine, as well as an implication that there would likely be a coup attempt made by the Biden administration and Burisma. These articles referenced range from 30 August - 25 October 2020, and are both SouthFront original content and republications from other websites. The Strategic Culture Foundation has been <u>publicly attributed</u> to be directed by Russia's Foreign Intelligence Service, or SVR.





As of 29 October, we found at least two original articles from New Eastern Outlook that focus on Hunter Biden's alleged financial dealings, corruption, and dubious connections between Hunter and Joe Biden and sex trafficking. One of the articles is generally anti-U.S., with sarcastically negative mentions of President Trump and denunciations of Joe and Hunter Biden's alleged financial dealings.

Global Research (globalresearch[.]ca)

Global Research has a significant amount of content regarding Hunter Biden, though brief negative mentions of both Hunter and Joe Biden in articles only somewhat related to the alleged Hunter Biden scandals make it difficult to estimate how many articles Global Research has produced on the subject. Some of the content pertains to an "ex-CIA officer" discrediting assertions that the Hunter Biden laptop scandal is part of a Russian disinformation campaign. Many of the articles were critical of American social media companies for blocking salacious content pertaining to Hunter Biden. It dropped a bit in April and May, with six and seven cases per month, respectively. In June and July, it peaked again with 17 and 18 cases, respectively. Then it dropped again in August and September (one case each month). It's hard to explain the June and July waves of cases exactly. Nothing happened publicly in the trial process in those months. How Russia Today skirts high-tech blockade to reach US readers: RT continues to draw a large American audience, helped unwittingly by some of America's most prominent conservative websites. The reason: those news outlets agreed to join a distribution network that allows other members' content to be displayed on their home pages. The company responsible is Mixi.Media, which assembled a network of right-leaning publishers, including National Review, The Daily Caller and Newsmax, as well as mainstream sites like RealClearPolitics. Also in Mixi's fold are RT and Sputnik. Links that Mixi places on its partners' websites often appear under headings such as 'From Our Partners,' but the source isn't always clear until after the headline has been clicked. That is by design. Mixi is the largest source of RT's 'referral traffic' in the US, delivering 19% of visitors coming from other websites in July, not including social media.

4. (FOUO) OSC Disinformation Digest:

Removing coordinated inauthentic behavior on Facebook: Facebook has removed ten networks from various countries that were conducting coordinated inauthentic behavior. Targets included audiences in the US, Kenya, Botswana, Myanmar, Azerbaijan, Nigeria, Russia, the Philippines, South East Asia, Turkey, Syria, Ukraine, Japan, Armenia, Georgia, Belarus and Moldova. More than half of the networks targeted domestic audiences in their countries. Two of the networks engaged primarily in leaving comments on posts by media entities and public figures — relying on real people, not automation — to create the perception of wide-spread support of their narratives. OSC comment: DFRLab, Graphika and the Stanford Internet Observatory carried out independent analysis of these networks. **SOURCE:** Facebook

Summary: Fort Russ News (FRN) is an English language outlet based in Serbia and connected to the Center for Syncretic Studies, a Belgrade-based think-tank. The mission statement defines the "Western public" as the intended target audience, which it describes as suffering from deceitful "Corporate Media."

The mission statement's mention of a "new multi-polar world" is mirroring the Eurasianist ideology promulgated by Russian philosopher and Eurasian imperialist Aleksandr Dugin. This worldview is one that views itself as caught in a perpetual information war against the Western ideals of democracy and liberalism. The pseudo-academic Center for Syncretic Studies confirms this ideological stance, with a plethora of references to Dugin's obscure "Forth Political Theory" on its website.

Both FRN and the Center for Syncretic Studies clearly espouse pro-Kremlin narratives on core issues in Russia's foreign policy ambitions. FRN also devotes much attention to the spreading of conspiracy theories, with an edge towards "The Deep State" and "The Anglo-Zionist Empire" to include COVID-19 health and vaccine disinformation and disinformation targeting the 2020 U.S. presidential election.

The Editor-in-Chief of Fort Russ News and Director of the Center for Syncretic Studies is an American, who for Privacy Act reasons we are not able to research further.

The Center for Syncretic Studies (CSS) is a Serbia-based NGO that advocates for multi-polarity and anti-liberalism. It publishes Fort Russ News and has created the "projects" New Resistance Evropa, New Resistance North America, and Nova Resistência (Brazil).

This network of websites regularly publishes content that supports Russian geopolitical objectives and spreads COVID-19 disinformation that risks significant loss of life.

The CSS website, novaresistencia.org, has historically been registered by a Russian national and currently resides on an IP address reserved for "think tanks" used in Russian influence operations, including one run by Russian oligarch, Konstantin Malofeev.

Paul Antonopoulos, a research fellow at the Center for Syncretic Studies, is a frequent InfoBRICS author. InfoBRICS.org, a site run by InfoRos, Ltd., a Russian propaganda outfit financed by the Russian government and covertly run by GRU Unit 54777.

A trusted GEC third-party partner assesses with high confidence that the Center for Syncretic Studies and its network of websites represent a Russian gray propaganda influence operation linked to the Russian government.

Summary: Zero Hedge is a wildly popular blog devoted to reporting primarily on finance. Much of the material is published under the pen name Tyler Durden — one of the main characters of the 1999 movie Fight Club. The blog has been online since 2009 and has proven to be able to occasionally present correct prognoses on financial processes. The content is of an almost consequently pessimistic nature, with frequent warnings on various "bubbles" about to burst. Court records reveal that the site belongs to ABC Media Ltd., a Bulgarian company whose sole manager is Krassimir Ivandjiisky.

In the spring of 2016, it was disclosed that the team behind "Tyler Durden" were Bulgarian economist Daniel Ivandjiisky, son of site owner Krassimir Ivandjiisky, and two American financial analysts. While these individuals cannot be researched further due to Privacy Act restrictions, one of them stated in a <u>public interview</u> in 2016 that "the gig had a certain formula: Russia=good. Obama=idiot. Bashar al-Assad=benevolent leader. John Kerry=dunce. Vladimir Putin=greatest leader in the history of statecraft."

Since the autumn of 2014, after Russia's illegal annexation of Crimea, Zero Hedge has proliferated pro-Russian narratives. Example topics covered include those claiming that there

was massive voter fraud in the U.S. 2020 presidential election; that COVID-19 escaped from a lab in Wuhan "accidentally or not;" that the coronavirus genome contains components of HIV; that the downing of Flight MH17 was a pretext for the NATO invasion of eastern Ukraine; and that "the Ukrainian government just indicted the Burisma gas company & named Hunter Biden for accepting millions of dollars from a slush fund" to name only a few.

Zero Hedge has published a manifesto describing the site's ambitions:

- to widen the scope of financial, economic and political information available to the professional investing public.
- to skeptically examine and, where necessary, attack the flaccid institution that financial journalism has become.
- · to liberate oppressed knowledge.
- to provide analysis uninhibited by political constraint.
- to facilitate information's unending quest for freedom.

The site links to other websites in Russia's disinformation and propaganda ecosystem such as SouthFront, Oriental Review, the Saker and other sites aligned with the Kremlin.

Zero Hedge has been censored on social media in the past, but remains highly active on Twitter and Facebook. The site also maintains a YouTube channel that has been inactive since February 2019.

News Front Georgia (Crimea)

Summary: News Front Georgia is the Georgian language branch of News Front, a Crimea-based disinformation and propaganda outlet. News Front's self-proclaimed goal is to provide an "alternative source of information" to Western audiences. With reported ties to the Russian security services and Kremlin funding, News Front is particularly focused on supporting Russia-backed forces in Ukraine.

In addition to Georgian, News Front publishes content in Slovak, Hungarian, French, Serbian, Spanish, German, Bulgarian, English, and Russian. According to public reporting, News Front has at least 100 contributors around the world.

News Front's manipulative tactics to boost reach led to a near total dismantling of its presence on social media in early 2020. In April 2020, Facebook removed a network of accounts associated with News Front Georgia, for "violating... [Facebook's] policy against foreign interference which is coordinated inauthentic behavior on behalf of a foreign entity."

The International Society for Fair Elections and Democracy (ISFED), a Georgian civil society group, <u>concluded</u> that News Front's Facebook activity in the country included theft of platform users' identities. It detailed News Front's efforts "instigating antagonism and aggression among Georgian Facebook users, dividing the society...creating political polarization" and "employing a range of tactics to spread anti-Western, pro-Russian messages."

According to a Georgian counter-disinformation project Myth Detector, News Front Georgia is managed by Shota Apkhaidze, a Moscow-based pro-Russian activist, associated with ultranationalist movement, "Georgian March." Apkhaidze is a frequent guest on Russian state and pro-Kremlin media including Sputnik, Zvezda TV and Tsargrad.

According to Myth Detector, News Front Georgia's Facebook page is linked to pro-Russian assets such as Georgia and World, Eurasian Union, and Patriot TV

News Front Georgia spreads disinformation regarding Covid-19. <u>According</u> to ISFED, they focus on the following narratives:

- Europe is powerless in the face of the pandemic and Georgia should align itself with Russia;
- Quarantine and social distancing policies do not work;
- The role of the Lugar Lab in helping Georgia is exaggerated. China is the one who is truly helping Georgia;
- COVID-19 virus did not originate naturally in China. The United States created the virus artificially and disseminated it through its military and the Lugar Lab;
- By declaring the state of emergency, the authorities are fighting against the Orthodox Church, not the virus.

Summary: The Duran is a Panama-registered site with a strong pro-Kremlin tendencies. It is owned by a Cypriot company, DRN Media PLC, which is headed by Moscow native and current resident of Nicosia, Cyprus, Alex Christoforou. A prominent American RT show host, whom we are unable to profile due to Privacy Act restrictions, directs and writes for the outlet. According to the Telegraph, the editor of the website is Alexander Mercouris, a disbarred London-based attorney who went on to become a "pro-Russian commentator on world affairs for Russian TV news outlets and websites."

The content on the site closely follows and republishes RT and Sputnik's reporting, covering topics like U.S. politics, Syria, the downfall of the West, and the supremacy of the Eurasian idea. Buzzword concepts like "the deep state" and "mainstream media are common on the site. Recent disinformation claims include those blaming the United States for COVID-19, those attempting to disparage notable figures on the American left, and those alleging there was massive voter fraud in the 2020 U.S. presidential election.

The Duran republishes content from a number of other outlets in Russia's disinformation and propaganda ecosystem, including SouthFront, ZeroHedge, and the Strategic Culture Foundation, which has been attributed to Russia's Foreign Intelligence Service, or SVR.

Funding for The Duran comes from Paypal and Patreon donations, as well as advertising.

Summary: Global Research is the name of the website of the Centre for Research on Globalization in Canada. It launched in August 2001 and has been a steady source of anti-U.S. and anti-Western disinformation and propaganda ever since. The Economist referred to it as "a hub for conspiracy theories and fake stories." Internet watchdog NewsGuard noted, "[t]his website severely violates basic standards of credibility and transparency.

Global Research founder and head Michel Chossudovsky is a retired professor who runs the website from his "upscale condo in Old Montreal." Chossudovsky has met with, backed, and praised anti-Western world leaders, including former Yugoslav President Slobodan Milosevic Fidel Castro of Cuba. Chossudovsky used to be a regular contributor to the Russian state-funded outlet RT, and Global Research often republishes RT's content.

Global Research's large roster of fringe authors and conspiracy theorists serves as a talent pool for the Russian and Chinese websites with which Global Research has partnered since the early 2010s, including the Chinese website The 21st Century and the SVR-linked Strategic Culture Foundation. Its publications also provide a Western voice that other elements of the ecosystem can leverage to their advantage. Articles published from across Russia's disinformation and propaganda ecosystem frequently appear on Global Research's website, including those from RT, Sputnik, SouthFront, Fort Russ News, Geopolitica.ru, and many others.

Global Research is a rampant proliferator of pro-Russian content. Additionally, the outlet is well-known for spreading disinformation claiming that COVID-19 is a U.S. bioweapon, that there was widespread fraud in the 2020 U.S. presidential election, that vaccines are deadly, and that 9/11 was an inside job.

Global Research published or republished seven authors attributed by Facebook to be false online personas created by The Main Directorate of the General Staff of the Armed Forces of the Russian Federation, popularly known as the GRU. Altogether, these seven GRU personas are responsible for 108 articles that appear on Global Research's website.

Summary: The Alexander Gorchakov Public Diplomacy Fund was founded by the Russian Ministry of Foreign Affairs in 2010 at the decree of President Dmitriy Medvedev. The Fund's stated mission is to establish "a favorable for Russia public, political and business climate."

The Fund's Board of Trustees includes the Russian Minister of Foreign Affairs Sergey Lavrov, as well as a number of current and former Russian government officials and prominent businessmen, including the U.S.-sanctioned Rostec's Director General, Sergei Chemezov, and the former chairman of the board of the Russian state-owned company Russian Railways, Vladimir Yakunin.

The Fund's main activities include offering grants to NGOs and organizing public diplomacy events including conferences and lectures. The Fund runs several research and educational programs aimed at strengthening ties between Russian and foreign youth from the Balkans, Central Asia, Baltic countries, and the Caucasus. It provides training for young foreign affairs experts, scientists, journalists and politicians. These programs provide participants an opportunity to meet with prominent Russian foreign affairs scholars and government officials.

The Fund also organizers conferences with foreign affairs experts from Germany and Slovakia and operates the Russian-Georgian Center, which aims at improving Russian-Georgian relations.

(U) Current Observations and Analysis on Convergence Themes in the Information Environment

Russia Accused Ukraine of Bombing its Own POWs in Olenivka. In an attempt to deflect blame and discredit U.S. military assistance to Ukraine, the Russian government, via its UN Twitter account, accused Ukraine of using U.S.-made high-mobility artillery rocket systems (HIMARS) in the July 29 bombing of Olenivka prison, Donetsk Oblast, which led to the killing of over 50 Ukrainian prisoners of war (POWs). Russian representative to the UN, Dmitry Polyanskiy, described the bombing as a "proxy war against Russia." While Russia continues to block the Red Cross from accessing the Olenivka prison, the Russian disinformation ecosystem went on the offensive through outlets such RT Arabic, RT Última Hora, and Russian embassy accounts, to show Russia's readiness to cooperate with the United Nations and the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) investigators. The ecosystem also touted Russia's humanitarian treatment of Ukrainian POWs, including those from the "neo-Nazi" Azov Battalion.



(U) New GEC Snapshots on Russia's Disinformation on Ukraine: On July 28 and August 2, GEC released two Snapshots on Russia's disinformation trends on Ukraine. The first overviews Foreign Minister Lavrov's Ukraine disinformation during his visit to Congo, Uganda, and Ethiopia, pro-Kremlin media claims that Russia's FSB foiled a plot by Ukraine's military intelligence to highjack Russian jets, and how the Russian propaganda and disinformation ecosystem weaponizes maps to question the legitimacy of Ukraine's statehood. The second Snapshot analyzed Kremlin narratives alleging prisoner of war deaths in Russian-occupied Olenivka were caused by a Ukrainian "provocation," how Russia's disinformation and propaganda ecosystem is promoting the false narrative that the United States is behind renewed unrest between Serbia and Kosovo to distract from unrealized goals in Ukraine, and Kremlin plans to carry out a "referendum" in occupied Kherson exposed by the Security Service of Ukraine that included establishing "election commissions" and organizing pro-Russian demonstrations. 

[Australia] Australia Demands China Apologize After 'Repugnant' Afghan Tweet Bloomberg [11/29/2020 10:13 PM, Jason Scott, 6400K, Negative] reports Australian Prime Minister Scott Morrison said he was seeking an apology from China after a diplomat in Beijing tweeted an image purporting to show an Australian soldier holding a knife to the throat of an Afghan child. The tweet, posted by Chinese Foreign Ministry spokesman Zhao Lijian, was "repugnant," Morrison told reporters in Canberra on Monday. The Australian premier said the image was doctored and called for Twitter to remove it. "The Chinese government should be totally ashamed of this post," Morrison said. The tweet will diminish China's global reputation, he said. Morrison's calls for an apology further ramps up tensions between the nations, following China's decision to impose crippling anti-dumping duties on its wine over the weekend. Diplomatic ties have plummeted this year after Australia called for independent investigators to be allowed into Wuhan to probe the origin of the pandemic, leading to a series of trade reprisals.

Trump senior aide Kushner and team heading to Saudi Arabia, Qatar

Reuters [11/29/2020 3:40 PM, Steve Holland, Neutral] reports White House senior adviser Jared Kushner and his team are headed to Saudi Arabia and Qatar this week for talks in a region simmering with tension after the killing of an Iranian nuclear scientist. A senior

administration official said on Sunday that Kushner is to meet Saudi Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman in the Saudi city of Neom, and the emir of Qatar in that country in the coming days. Kushner will be joined by Middle East envoys Avi Berkowitz and Brian Hook and Adam Boehler, chief executive of the U.S. International Development Finance Corporation. Kushner and his team helped negotiate normalization deals between Israel and Bahrain, the United Arab Emirates and Sudan since August. The official said they would like to advance more such agreements before President Donald Trump hands power to President-elect Joe Biden on Jan. 20. U.S. officials believe enticing Saudi Arabia into a deal with Israel would prompt other Arab nations to follow suit. But the Saudis do not appear to be on the brink of reaching such a landmark deal and officials in recent weeks have been focusing on other countries, with concern about Iran's regional influence a uniting factor. Kushner's trip comes after the killing on Friday of Mohsen Fakhrizadeh in Tehran by unidentified assailants. Western and Israeli governments believe Fakhrizadeh was the architect of a secret Iranian nuclear weapons program. Days before the killing, Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu travelled to Saudi Arabia and met with bin Salman, an Israeli official said, in what was the first publicly confirmed visit by an Israeli leader. Israeli media said they were joined by U.S. Secretary of State Mike Pompeo.

China Urges U.S. to Drop Probe That Claims Yuan Undervalued

Bloomberg [11/30/2020 12:34 AM, Staff, 6400K, Neutral] reports China said a preliminary U.S. ruling that it allegedly provided a trade subsidy to some exporters by undervaluing the yuan violated international rules. The case relates to a U.S. investigation into Chinese exports of cable or twist ties, with the U.S. Department of Commerce imposing tariffs on the products after determining that producers are getting an unfair advantage because of the currency. China's Commerce Ministry called on U.S. authorities to stop its investigation, while also disputing the preliminary finding. "The move seriously violated relevant international rules." China's ministry said in a statement on its website Saturday, citing an unidentified official. "We hope the U.S. Department of Commerce will fully consider the evidence and counter opinions submitted by the Chinese side and correct the relevant wrong practices and conclusions." The claim by the U.S. that the yuan's exchange rate to the dollar was undervalued by 5% in 2019 is "completely wrong" and isn't supported by any analysis, the ministry said. It cited a U.S. Treasury report on the yuan for that figure, which wasn't in the Commerce Department statement.

SCO Heads of Government Summit Today: Indian PM Narendra Modi & Pakistani Counterpart Imran Khan to Skip Meeting

Yahoo News/Latestly [11/29/2020 10:12 PM, Staff, 4021K, Neutral] reports India will host the Heads of Government (HoG) council meeting of the eight-nation Shanghai Cooperation Organisation on Monday. According to reports, Indian PM Narendra Modi will not the meeting and instead Vice president M Venkaiah Naidu will chair the meeting. The virtual conference will be attended by six Prime Ministers, including Chinese Premier Li Kegiang and Russian Prime Minister Mikhail Mishustin, as well as the PMs of Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan, and Kazakhstan. Pakistani counterpart Imran Khan will also not join the virtual meeting and he has deputed his Parliamentary Secretary for Foreign Affairs Andleeb Abbas in his place. "It will be the first time that a Summit-level Meeting will be held under India's Chairmanship since it gained full membership of the organization in 2017," the MEA statement read, adding that, "This Summit is held annually at the level of Prime Ministers of SCO and deals primarily with the trade and economic agenda of the organisation."

[Iran] Iran's Nuclear Efforts Pose Growing Threat to Its Foes Despite Setbacks The Wall Street Journal [11/29/2020 5:37 PM, Laurence Norman and Michael R. Gordon, Neutral] reports the killing of one of Iran's most important nuclear scientists has dealt a setback to the country's nuclear program, which had staged a partial rebound after the 2015 nuclear deal brokered under President Obama unraveled. Yet, the U.S. and its allies still face major hurdles in trying to constrain Tehran's nuclear ambitions, current and former officials said. The challenge is likely to be particularly acute for President-elect Joe Biden, who is planning to engage Iran diplomatically in the hope of negotiating restoring and building on the 2015 deal. Mr. Biden will inherit considerable economic leverage in his dealings with Tehran: The sweeping sanctions the Trump administration has imposed on Iran after withdrawing from the agreement in 2018 have depleted Iran's currency reserves and battered its economy. But the fatal shooting of Mohsen Fakhrizadeh, widely seen as the father of Iran's weapons program in the 1990s and 2000s, and the American strike in January in Baghdad that killed top Iranian military official Qassem Soleimani, is also expected to complicate Mr. Biden's task. "To restore its economy Iran must agree to either a full or partial return to the Iran nuclear deal," said Karim Sadjadpour, an Iran expert at the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace. But "to restore deterrence and regime pride, Iran must avenge the deaths of Fakhrizadeh and Soleimani. The latter will significantly complicate the former, which is likely among the reasons why Fakhrizadeh was assassinated." Iran has long said that its nuclear activities are for purely peaceful purposes, such as power plants. It has hailed Mr. Fakhrizadeh as a hero and accused Israel of being behind his killing.

[Iran] Iran under intense pressure over how to respond to top scientist's killing The Los Angeles Times [11/29/2020 5:30 PM, Nabih Bulos, 1825K, Neutral] reports the U.S. drone missile punched through the car of Iranian Maj. Gen. Qassem Suleimani, instantly killing the 62-year-old Iranian spymaster and national hero as he drove through the streets of Baghdad last January. Days later, Iranian leaders who swore "severe revenge" lobbed ballistic missiles at a U.S. base in Iraq, leaving scores of American servicemen and contractors with traumatic brain injuries. Iran also mobilized its irregular forces, including Iran-supported militias in Iraq, which regularly fired rockets at the U.S. Embassy and bases with American troop presence. Now, Iran finds itself the target of another attack, this time the broad-daylight assassination on Friday of Mohsen Fakhrizadeh-Mahabadi, one of Iran's top nuclear scientists. The killing, by what many believed was a U.S.-sanctioned Israeli hit team, has ratcheted up the pressure on Iran's leaders for vengeance again. On Friday afternoon, as Iranians were enjoying the first day of their weekend amid coronavirus restrictions, Fakhrizadeh was in a car heading down a highway near the resort town of Absard, some 35 miles east of Tehran. There, a car loaded with explosives blew up, and gunmen descended on Farkhizadeh, cutting him down along with members of his security detail. CNN [11/29/2020 10:57 PM, Sara Mazloumsaki and Eliott C. McLaughlin, 7975K, Negative] reports the Iranian nuclear scientist assassinated Friday east of Tehran was shot by a remote-controlled machine gun operating out of another car, the semi-official Fars News Agency said Sunday. With top Iranian officials blaming Israel, Supreme Leader Ayatollah Seyyed Ali Khamenei and others have promised revenge for the killing of Mohsen Fakhrizadeh, who was the country's chief nuclear scientist. The AP [11/30/2020 1:16 AM, Staff, 2164K, Negative] reports Iran has begun a funeral for a recently killed scientist who founded the Islamic Republic's military nuclear program in the early 2000s. State TV broadcast the ceremony Monday showing the casket of Mohsen Fakhrizadeh. An honor

guard carried it to a podium where reciters read the Quran and other religious verses in an outdoor area of the Defense Ministry in Iran's capital, Tehran.

[Iraq] Rocket attack causes fire at oil refinery in northern Iraq

The AP [11/29/2020 2:47 PM, Staff, Negative] reports a rocket attack in northern Iraq on Sunday caused a large fire to break out at an oil refinery, briefly halting operations, the country's Oil Ministry said. The fire hit a fuel storage tank at the small Siniya refinery in Salahuddin province. There were no reports of casualties, the ministry statement said. The fire was extinguished and operations resumed within few hours after the attack, the ministry said, citing the state-owned Northern Refining Company that runs the refinery. The Siniya refinery is near Irag's largest oil refinery, Baiji, which sustained major damage during the war against the Islamic State group. The refinery was overhauled and eventually reopened in 2017 following the extremist group's defeat. It was not immediately clear who was behind Sunday's attack. Although IS no longer holds territory in Iraq, the group maintains sleeper cells and frequently carries out attacks across parts of the country, including the north.

[France] Almost 100 Police Officers injured during Saturday protests in France Yahoo News/ANI [11/29/2020 5:40 PM, Staff, 4021K, Neutral] reports the tally of French law enforcement officers injured as a result of Saturday nationwide protests against the new security legislation has been finalized at 98 people, French Interior Minister Gerald Darmanin said on Sunday. On Saturday, protests were held in over 70 cities across France, most actively in Paris, against the new draft law criminalizing the display of images of law enforcement officers. The rallies in Paris grew into unrest and clashes with police. "Final assessment -- 98 wounded among the police and gendarmes. I express my full support for them. The perpetrators of this violence must be held accountable," Darmanin said on Twitter. The minister's previous update on Saturday evening stated 37 law enforcement officers injured. The controversial legislation was passed at the French parliament's lower house on Tuesday, immediately sparking a broad public decry, especially among journalists. The bill entails one-year imprisonment and a fine of 45,000 euros (USD 54,000) in punishment for the distribution of images of police officers and gendarmes that can potentially lead to their physical and psychological harm.

[Turkey] Turkey's military campaign beyond its borders is powered by homemade armed drones

The Washington Post [11/29/2020 4:36 PM, Kareem Fahim, 13480K, Neutral] reports as Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan wages a widening military campaign for influence from North Africa to the Caucasus, his forces have relied on a potent weapon to gain a battlefield edge while drumming up domestic support for foreign interventions: homemade armed drones. Their impact has been substantial. The drones played a central role in recent months in shifting Libya's civil war in favor of the Turkish-backed government based in the capital, Tripoli, and they helped Azerbaijan, an ally of Turkey, prevail over Armenian forces in the fighting over the contested Nagorno-Karabakh region, according to military analysts. In northern Syria, Turkish drones played a major part this year in a series of devastating attacks on Syrian armored forces that caught some military observers by surprise and helped bring a Syrian government offensive against rebel areas to a halt. At home, the drones have become a symbol of Turkish technological innovation and self-sufficiency, boosting national confidence amid a severe economic downturn and friction with some other NATO countries. But the battlefield successes pose an urgent foreign policy challenge for

the incoming Biden administration: what to do about Ankara's expansionist policies, which have put Turkey in conflict with a range of other U.S. allies, including Greece and the United Arab Emirates. James Jeffrey, a former U.S. ambassador to Turkey who served until recently as the Trump administration's special representative for Syria, said Turkey's foreign forays had "stymied" Russian military ambitions in places like Syria and Libya, and "that's not a bad thing." At the same time, he said, "Erdogan scares the hell out of most everyone in the Middle East." The Turkish leader "is very unpredictable and very ambitious. He is moving into vacuums."

[United Kingdom] U.K. Unveils 5G Plan Banning Huawei Installations

Bloomberg [11/29/2020 7:01 PM, Thomas Seal, 6400K, Neutral] reports the U.K. will ban the installation of 5G equipment from China's Huawei Technologies Co. by the end of next September. The restriction, first reported by Bloomberg last Monday, is part of a 250 millionpound (\$333 million) package of measures brought in to diversify Britain's wireless supply chain announced by the Department for Digital, Culture, Media and Sport. The stricter rules may also help fend off a challenge from lawmakers in the ruling Conservative Party seeking tighter restrictions on the Chinese network equipment maker. British ministers announced in July that Shenzhen-based Huawei would be totally banned from Britain's next-generation mobile networks in 2027, with purchases barred from January 2021. To comply with those rules, phone companies would have had to stop adding Huawei components eventually, but the new ban may accelerate their plans to overhaul systems. Maintaining existing equipment will be allowed. The crackdown followed a U.S. push for allies to exclude Huawei on the grounds it was an unacceptable security threat, which the company denies. In January, British officials said Huawei could play a limited role with manageable risks. They since reversed that stance and backed a ban following U.S. sanctions introduced in May, saying the American squeeze on Huawei's silicon supply chain meant its security could no longer be guaranteed. Reuters [11/29/2020 10:19 PM, William James, 4021K, Neutral] reports China has criticised that decision, while Huawei said last week it was disappointed Britain was looking to exclude it from the 5G roll-out after the publication of new laws that could see firms fined 100,000 pounds (\$133,140) if they break the ban. Monday's announcement comes ahead of a debate over new telecoms legislation in parliament and fleshes out the timeline for equipment removal. "I am setting out a clear path for the complete removal of high risk vendors from our 5G networks," digital minister Oliver Dowden said in a statement. "This will be done through new and unprecedented powers to identify and ban telecoms equipment which poses a threat to our national security."

[Australia] Australia Demands China Apologize After 'Repugnant' Afghan Tweet Bloomberg [11/29/2020 10:13 PM, Jason Scott, 6400K, Negative] reports Australian Prime Minister Scott Morrison said he was seeking an apology from China after a diplomat in Beijing tweeted an image purporting to show an Australian soldier holding a knife to the throat of an Afghan child. The tweet, posted by Chinese Foreign Ministry spokesman Zhao Lijian, was "repugnant," Morrison told reporters in Canberra on Monday. The Australian premier said the image was doctored and called for Twitter to remove it. "The Chinese government should be totally ashamed of this post," Morrison said. The tweet will diminish China's global reputation, he said. Morrison's calls for an apology further ramps up tensions between the nations, following China's decision to impose crippling anti-dumping duties on its wine over the weekend. Diplomatic ties have plummeted this year after Australia called

[China] EU proposes new post-Trump alliance with U.S. in face of China threat Reuters [11/29/2020 4:06 PM, Anirudh Saligrama, 5304K, Neutral] reports the European Union is seeking to forge a new alliance with the United States to bury the tensions of the Trump era and meet the challenges posed by China, the Financial Times reported on Sunday, citing a draft plan. The plan proposes rebuilding ties with common fronts on issues from digital regulation to tackling the COVID-19 pandemic, the FT said. Relations between the United States and Europe have been strained under President Donald Trump. The EU and most of the bloc's states have congratulated President-elect Joe Biden. "As open democratic societies and market economies, the EU and the US agree on the strategic challenge presented by China's growing international assertiveness, even if we do not always agree on the best way to address this," the FT cited the draft plan as saying. The plan, which will be submitted for endorsement by national leaders at a meeting on Dec. 10-11, proposed the launch of a new transatlantic agenda in an EU-U.S. summit in the first half of 2021, the newspaper added.

[North Korea] North Korea tightening borders to build 'wall of defense' against COVID-19

FOX News [11/29/2020 9:00 PM, Staff, Neutral] reports North Korea has tightened its borders to build a "wall of defense" against the COVID-19 pandemic, state media said Sunday. The Hermit Kingdom has increased its number of guard posts and was "building a strong wall of defense at its borders," CNN reported, citing state-run Korean Central News Agency. The country is also working to "completely remove uncivilized and unhygienic elements that could help make room for the spread of an epidemic" during the winter. according to the report. These measures will include new rules about venturing out to sea and collecting potentially contaminated materials. South Korean intelligence officials told lawmakers that North Korean leader Kim Jong-Un banned fishing and salt production to prevent seawater from being infected with the virus. Ha Tae-keung, one of the South Korean officials briefed on the matter, said he had been told that the despot was displaying "excessive anger" and taking "irrational measures" over the pandemic and its economic repercussions. The new measures come despite North Korea insisting that it hasn't had a single COVID-19 case, though experts outside the country have been skeptical of that claim pointing out that it shares a border with China, the original source of the outbreak.

[Sri Lanka] Sri Lanka coronavirus prison riot leaves 8 dead, over 50 wounded Reuters [11/30/2020 2:50 AM, Waruna Karunatilake, Neutral] reports at least eight prisoners were killed and more than 50 injured in clashes with guards at a Sri Lankan prison, officials said on Monday, as authorities tried to guell a protest over rising corornavirus infections in the country's crowded jails. Sri Lanka has witnessed an upsurge in coronavirus cases in the past month and over-congested prisons across the country have reported thousands of fresh infections. Inmates have staged protests in recent weeks demanding an increase in coronavirus testing and new isolation facilities for infected prisoners. The latest clash at Mahara prison situated on the outskirts of the capital Colombo started on Sunday when some inmates protested against prisoners infected by the Covid-19 virus being transferred from other facilities to Mahara. "We can't say it for certain but most of the deaths and injuries appear to be due to gunshots," said Ajith Rohana, a senior police

official tracking the incident. Hundreds of additional police were deployed to help the guards and strengthen security at the prison. "A majority of prisoners injured in the Mahara jail clashes were in critical condition," said Shelton Perera, director of the Ragama Hospital where inmates from the prison were undergoing treatment.

[Mexico] Mexico charges ex-security chief who faces trial in US

The AP [11/29/2020 3:56 PM, Maria Verza, 2164K, Neutral] reports Mexican officials said Sunday they want to prosecute former security chief Genaro Gará Luna in his own country, despite the fact he faces trial in the U.S. for allegedly protecting a drug gang. The action follows a U.S. decision to drop charges against another former top Mexican official accused of drug links, ex-Defense Secretary Salvador Cienfuegos, and leave any prosecution up to Mexico. A federal official told The Associated Press on Sunday that the Attorney General's Office had issued an arrest warrant on Friday for former Public Security Secretary García Luna and that officials "are assessing the viability of starting an extradition process." The official, who spoke on condition of anonymity for lack of authorization to discuss the case publicly, said García Luna is accused here of illegal enrichment. García Luna served as security chief under former President Felipe Calderón from 2006 to 2012 as the leader in the government's fight against organized crime. He was arrested in December in Texas and pleaded not guilty last month to drug trafficking charges, including a new one of engaging in a continuing criminal enterprise. U.S. prosecutors accuse him of accepting tens of millions of dollars in bribes — often stuffed in briefcases full of cash — to shield the Sinaloa cartel from law enforcement. In January, the former Mexican official pleaded not guilty to charges of cocaine trafficking conspiracy and a false statement. The United States earlier this month dropped a drug trafficking and money laundering case against Cienfuegos, an extraordinary reversal that followed an intense pressure campaign from Mexico. A judge in New York City approved the dismissal of charges and the general was quickly sent back to Mexico, where so far he faces no charges.

[Nigeria] Nigeria buries 43 farmers killed by militants, dozens missing

Reuters [11/29/2020 7:05 PM, Lanre Ola, 11261K, Negative] reports villagers in northeast Nigeria's Borno state on Sunday buried 43 farmers killed in an attack by suspected Islamist militants while security forces searched for dozens still missing. Around 30 of the men were beheaded in the attack, which began on Saturday morning in the village of Zabarmari, while residents said 70 people in all are feared dead. While there was no claim of responsibility, such massacres have been carried out in the past by Boko Haram or the Islamic State West Africa Province which are both active in the area, where Islamic militants have killed at least 30,000 people. Nigerian President Muhammadu Buhari condemned the killings and said "the entire country is hurt". In Zabarmari, dozens of mourners surrounded the bodies, which were wrapped in white burial shrouds and placed on wooden pallets, as clerics led prayers for the deceased. One resident and Amnesty International said 10 women were among those missing. United Nations humanitarian coordinator Edward Kallon said he was "outraged and horrified" by "the most violent direct attack" against civilians this year. The U.N. estimated that at least 110 people were killed across the Jere local government area of Borno state. Yahoo News/ANI [11/29/2020 7:05 PM, Staff, 4021K, Negative] reports the death toll from an attack on farmers in a village in Nigeria's northeastern state of Borno has risen to 110, with many wounded, a United Nations official said on Sunday. Edward Kallon, the UN Resident and Humanitarian Coordinator in Nigeria, condemned the incident, in which several women were also kidnapped by the terror group Boko Haram suspected of

being responsible for the attack on Saturday. Nigerian authorities earlier on Sunday confirmed more than 40 farmers were killed after Boko Haram militants launched the attack at Koshebe village in the Mafa local government area of the state while working on their farmlands.




